- Make play dough -

2 Cups Flour

1 Cup salt

1 Tablespoon Oil

1 Tablespoon Cream of Tartar

2 Cups of Water

Food Colouring (But not essential)

Add ingredients to large saucepan and heat on medium heat, whilst constantly stirring with a wooden spoon. Once it begins to come away at the sides, take off heat and knead.
