Literacy (Book Focus: The Rainbow Fish).	<p>Watch some parts of the underwater video (as much as you wish) https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=n4tzUnGv-yI Talk about the different creatures that live under the sea.</p> <p>Read the first page of the story.</p> <p>Write a sentence about Rainbow Fish - think about words like bright, sparkly, glittery, shiny etc.</p>	<p>Read up to blue fish asking Rainbow Fish for a scale.</p> <p>Talk about what Rainbow Fish might say. Do you think he will be nice or not?</p> <p>Write a sentence in a speech bubble for what Rainbow Fish might say.</p>	<p>Read the next page where none of the fish are talking to Rainbow Fish.</p> <p>What do we think about Rainbow Fish - think about words like - mean, unkind, selfish, horrible etc.</p> <p>How do the other fish feel - angry, cross, disappointed, annoyed etc.</p> <p>Write a sentence about how the other fish are feeling about Rainbow Fish.</p>	<p>Read the page where Rainbow Fish is talking to the starfish.</p> <p>Now look at the picture of Rainbow Fish talking to the octopus.</p> <p>What advice do you think octopus will give to Rainbow Fish?</p> <p>Write a sentence in a speech bubble for what you think octopus will say.</p>	<p>Independent writing day</p> <p>Use the independent writing image to inspire your writing.</p> <p>Could you write a story, a fictile, a description etc.</p>
Maths (Focus: Money)	<p>Show children different coins (up to the value of £1). Talk through the value of these and the size/colour. Put them into order of value</p> <p>Introduce calculating with coins, Add up 1p coins to buy various different objects up to a value of 20p.</p>	<p>Practise coin recognition. Can you order them on your own?</p> <p>Today, play shops using values of 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p and £1. Practise paying with one coin, the correct amount.</p>	<p>Partially reveal a coin and ask the children to guess what the coin is before it is fully revealed. Repeat with different coins (don't be afraid to use the same coin twice!).</p> <p>Price up some items, all with a value of 5p or lower. Using only 1p coins, see if your child can pay for these items and draw a number sentence to show this. Progress to using 1p and 2p coins, again writing number sentences for these also.</p>	<p>Create some amounts in a purse/container (or draw these). Ask your child how much is in here and how can we check? Use 1p, 2p and 5p to add.</p> <p>Repeat a few times for different amounts.</p>	<p>As with yesterday, create some amounts for you child to add, but use coins up to the value of 10p.</p> <p>Next, show two separate amounts. Ask your child to estimate which has more (ensure that you put more coins of a lower value in one - to show that just because you have more coins, it doesn't always mean a higher total). Check your answers and try a few more times.</p>
