Dear Parents,

We have made a weekly pack that coincides with the learning that the key worker children will be doing in school for Years 2 and 3. Below are some ideas and links to follow at home. Our theme this week is **habitats**. We have included a suggested timetable of daily tasks but please adapt this to suit your own timings. Please email either Miss Wilson or Miss Rees if you have any questions.

To ensure that the children are motivated to complete as many of these suggested activities as possible whilst at home - we would like for them to email us, or drop off into school (following social distancing guidelines) two of the learning activities they complete each week (highlighted in yellow). We, as their teachers, can then assess what they have done and provide feedback during the weekly phone call home where required.

Monday

English - gather ideas and interesting vocabulary around the picture

Maths - addition using column addition (10 questions)

PSHE - positives from lockdown

Science - pond and ocean habitats

Tuesday

English - write first paragraph using noticing lens (what can you see in the picture?)

Maths - addition estimating

SPaG - writing sentences with prepositions

Science - arctic and desert habitats

Wednesday

English - write second paragraph using action lens (what are the animals doing?)

Maths - subtraction using column addition (10 questions)

Reading - complete reading comprehension

Science - field and woodland habitats

Thursday

English - write third paragraph about sounds (animal noises, wind etc)

Maths - subtraction estimating

Spelling - choose 6-10 words from either the Year 2 or Year 3 spelling list. Practise using 'Look, cover, write, check' and put words into sentences.

Science - minibeast and their habitats

Friday

English - proof-read your work. Check your punctuation and spelling. Can you make any improvements?

Maths - addition and subtraction word problems

Handwriting - copy a page from your favourite book in your best joined-up handwriting

Science - design your own habitat

English

This week we will be writing a setting description about a habitat using this picture.



Gather ideas and create a word bank of interesting vocabulary. Use the following ideas to help you:

- Notice (What does the sky look like? Describe the sunset. Write a simile about the clouds.)
- Action (How are the rhinos moving? Describe the vultures sitting on the tree. Write about the elephants moving and the giraffe drinking.)
- Sounds (What noises do the animals make? Are the elephants making a noise? Can you hear the wind in the trees?)

Please include interesting adjectives, similes, conjunctions and expanded noun phrases. Remember to use capital letter, full stops and commas for lists. As a challenge you could use exciting fronted adverbials and alliteration.

We look forward to reading all of your wonderful descriptions!

This week we are revising the addition and subtraction methods as well as using estimating. **Year 2 will be using 2-digit numbers and Year 3 will be using 3-digit numbers.**

- Roll a dice or make your own number cards to create 2 or 3 digit numbers. Answer 10 questions of each.
