Phonics and Writing

We are learning our single alphabet sounds daily based on the Read Write Inc. phonic program. We will be starting to give out reading books within the next week. Please keep the same book for a week and tell the story as many times as you like. Write in the reading diaries each time you read as we will be starting our reading raffle! This raffle gives each child a ticket every Monday if they have read 5 times a week. At the end of each half term we draw the raffle and the winner chooses a book from our special bookcase.



Maths

We have begun to recognise and write our numbers to 10. We have been counting using different resources and finding different amounts of objects around the classroom to compare. We are using careful counting to make sure we can count accurately to 10!



Topic Learning

Over the next two weeks we will be learning about people who help us. Our specific focus will be on the emergency services, public services and their roles and responsibilities. We will be talking to a real fireman and he will show us his uniform and tell us about his job and duties. We will be reading lots of books about working together and sharing.
