


Summer Term 2

Phonics and Writing

Our phonics is absolutely amazing! We are so proud of how much the children know—so keep practising your 10 sets of High Frequency Words at home—and reading 5 times a week to get into the reading raffle.

Our writing is blowing us away! We are encouraging the children to write stories independently. Keep practising writing at home, too—we would love to see your wonderful writing!

Maths

Our Maths focus this half term is to be able to add and subtract independently using different methods. We are working on our bigger numbers now, and we are also getting ready for Year 1 by writing out number sentences and learning our 2, 5 and 10 times tables! Keep practicing with us, we are getting very good at it now!

Topic Learning

This final half term is our sea theme! We are looking at the different types of sea creatures lurking in the ocean, we are talking about the seaside (although unfortunately, not going!) sending postcards, reading about different beaches, learning about pirates... and we are going to make the most of the hot weather outside—between the rain.
