Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our summer topics 'Can a cat have wings?' and 'Kenya walk on the wild side?' we would like to offer a Year 1 and 2 trip to Woburn Safari park on **Friday 9th July**. This will be a really exciting day for the children to continue their learning outside the classroom, where they will see and learn about safari animals and explore the habitats they live in.

Drop off and collection times will be the same as usual on the day. Please make sure all children are wearing their full school uniform on the day.

On the day of the visit all children will need:

- A waterproof coat
- Sensible outdoor shoes
- A water bottle
- A packed lunch in a **named disposable bag**
- Sun cream applied if it is a sunny day
- A sun hat if sunny

Please note: if you have already booked a school packed lunch for your child for Friday 9th July, this will be given to your child on the day or if you would prefer to provide your child with a packed lunch from home please ensure this is in a named disposable bag.

In order to meet the cost of the visit, a voluntary contribution of **£14.95 per child** is required so that the trip can go ahead. This will cover the entry fee as well as coach hire to and from Woburn Safari Park. Payments can be made via Parent Mail.

Please complete the attached consent form and return to school by Friday 2nd July.
