

We will respect each other regardless of gender, race or background.




We are the beating heart of the community.


We teach the children about their local community of Fairfields, Stony Stratford and Milton Keynes, providing a bespoke curriculum to our cohort.

# What makes our curriculum cohesive? What are we teaching and why?



- Substantive concept threads throughout topics and year groups


#### **Our Values and Learning Power Pals**

## **Our Curriculum Intent**


