### Nursery Transition

Dear Parent/Carers,

We are extremely excited to welcome your child to our nursery class this next academic year. To help with a smooth transition, we are able to share with you some dates for you and your child to come into school and start building our partnership, to support your child's journey with us as they embark on their new venture!

**On Monday 10<sup>th</sup> July 4.30pm**, we are holding a workshop, for you to find out more about the transition for September, routines and expectations of your child's nursery year. It will also be an opportunity to meet some of our team who your child will be with next year. At this workshop, we will hand out packs for completion, which includes information you will need for your child's year in nursery. You will also have the opportunity to book your home visit slot for September.

Starting this week, on **Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> June**, we are opening the nursery classroom to start transitions for your child into our nursery. Every **Wednesday** and Thursday until the first transition session in school time (see below) we are inviting you and your child to come in for a settling in session. Please choose one date and call through to the office to book your session. We have a maximum of 6 children (and their grown-ups) available to attend each date and invite you to sign up for one date per child. The dates available are:

Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> June  
Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> June  
Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> June

Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> July

These sessions will run from **3.40pm-4.30pm** and we ask that you enter through the front of the school, where you will be asked to sign in. It offers the opportunity for your child to play within the environment and meet the team, with a smaller number of children around them, so to familiarise themselves with their new classroom before the first transition day for the class altogether (see below).

Following these sessions, **Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July 8.45-11.15am** is the first session we will hold for your child to meet their new friends and classmates together as a new nursery class. Please enter through the side gate (in the car park) where our staff will register your child for the session.

Following this, on **Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> July 1.30 - 3.20pm**, we are offering another opportunity for your child to come into the nursery as part of their settling in. After this afternoon session, we would like to invite you in to school, at **3.45pm**, to meet the nursery team. For the session, please use the side gate in the car park and if you would like to meet the team, please wait until **3.45pm** when you will be invited back to meet the team. Please be aware that we will need to see out our current nursery children at the end of their school day between **3.30pm and 3.40pm**.

We hope you and your child are excited to become part of our school, joining us as we grow and build our community. We look forward to welcoming you into the school very soon and encourage you to attend these events, so that we can answer any questions you may have.
