This term, we are starting our writing journey with a narrative focus.

The children will use their knowledge of the text Holes to explore different writing features. Each week will start with a SPaG focus and incorporate it into our high level, descriptive writing. We will then move onto letter writing! In Reading, we are exploring various texts and answering comprehension questions using our VIPER skills (Vocabulary, Inference, Predict, Explain and Retrieval)



In Maths, Year 6 are starting the year by exploring their previous knowledge of place value. They will be developing and building upon what they know by learning about numbers up to 10,000,000! The children will also have afternoon sessions which will focus on arithmetic, number fluency and reasoning. Understanding the value of each number and how it can be ordered, increased and decreased will support our future maths coverage.
