In writing lessons this half term we will be looking at the story 'In every house, on every street.' As a class we will build a bank of adventurous vocabulary and use this to create both a setting and character description.

Maths

In Maths, we will be looking at place value. We will be exploring at numbers up to 100 thinking carefully about how we can partition numbers into tens and ones.

Science

This half term, we are learning about materials. We will be investigating the different properties a range of materials possess and will conduct simple experiments with these. One of our experiments will focus on answering the question: can materials be changed by twisting, bending, stretching and squashing?
