English

Throughout this half term, we will be learning to identify and represent 4-digit numbers in a variety of ways, as well as ordering and comparing them. Following this, we will be learning to use the column method to solve addition and subtraction calculations and applying these skills to a range of problems.

In our science lessons this half term, we are going to be learning about electricity. We will be exploring electrical circuits and discovering the components needed to create them. We will also be investigating which materials are conductors and which are insulators.

During our geography lessons this half term, we will discover the countries and states located in North America. We will be learning what life is like in different North American states and will use maps to locate famous landmarks and physical features. In history, we will be learning how Britain first discovered America and what life was like in Native America compared to today.

In art, we will be studying the work of Andy Warhol and carefully observing how he uses contrasting colours in his work to make it stand out. We will discover the pop art movement and will use our knowledge of contrasting colours and brand logos to design and create a two colour print inspired by Andy Warhol.

During our music lessons, we will be identifying the structure and layers within pieces of music. We will be using body percussion to create our own musical rhythms and will work in small groups to build our own compositions.
