English

Maths

Throughout this half term, we will be learning how to multiply 3 digit numbers by one, two and three digit numbers. We will be using our knowledge of the column method and applying it to multiplication. We will also be learning how to divide using the 'bus stop' method and will be learning to solve a variety of problems.

Science

In our science lessons this half term, we are going to be learning about light, including sources of light, which surfaces are good reflectors and shadows. We will be learning that darkness is the absence of light and we need light to see. We will also discover how light can be reflected from different surfaces, and how some surfaces are better than others. Our topic will include shadows and experimenting how shadows are formed and how they change shape and size.

During our history lessons this half term we will be learning all about prehistoric history and how the order is Stone Age, Bronze Age, and Iron Age. This will include looking into what life was like during these times as well as exploring how our past has changed Great Britain and the impact this has had on our local area of Milton Keynes. In art, we will be studying the work of Beaker people and carefully observing how they constructed and created beakers in the Stone Age, Iron Age and Bronze Age. We will then use our knowledge of technique, styles, and patterns to design and create beakers that inspire us from the past. Our art lessons will also include the skill of weaving and creating our very own

As part of our music lessons, we will be developing their singing techniques. Learning to keep in time and work on musical notation. The children will finish the topic with a group performance of a songs with actions.
