English

As part of our times tables learning we will be learning multiplication and division number facts that relate to each times table.

In our science lessons this half term, we are going to be learning about animals and their habitats. We will begin by classifying animals and discovering the 6 different animal groups. We will also be learning more about habitats, how they change over time and how humans can impact them.

During our history lessons this half term we will be learning about the Romans. We will begin by discovering when Rome was built and when the rise of the Roman Empire was. We will also discover what life was like in Ancient Rome, how the Romans influenced change in Britain and the impact Romans had in Milton Keynes. In addition to this, we will be learning about significant individuals, including Julius Caesar and Boudicca, and why they are remembered today.

In DT, we will be studying Roman catapults and using these to help us design and create our own.

Once complete, we will evaluate our catapults and consider how we could improve these next time.

During our music lessons this half term, we will be learning the history of rock and roll music. We will be learning to perform the hand jive in sequence and in time with music and playing the notes of a walking bass in the correct sequence.
