

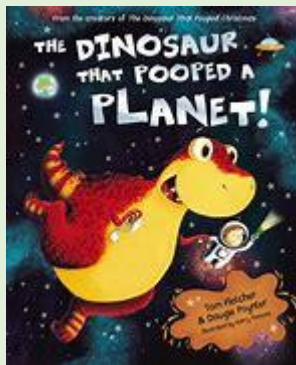
### Welcome back!

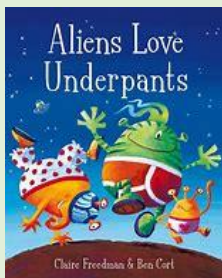

### Drawing Club book of the week



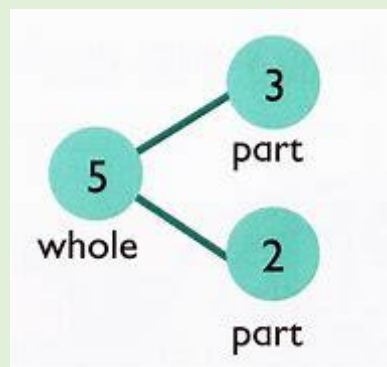
We will be reading 'The Dinosaur That Pooped a Planet' by Tom Fletcher and Dougie Poynter.

### Number

This week we will be exploring numbers 4 and 5 in more depth. We will be singing the song 'five little speckled frogs' to help embed the concept of one less. Then we move onto using numicon to represent the numbers and we will also practice forming our numbers correctly. Finally we will introduce the part-part-whole model and encourage the children to use this to represent different ways of making 4 and 5.



### Jigsaw PSHE

This week in our topic lessons we are thinking about recognising and managing our feelings. We will discuss ways in which we can help to control our emotions and try and understand the effect they can have on other people. We will think about why it is important to use kind words and have kind hands and see if we can identify kind and unkind actions.
