English

This half term we are going to be using the book The boy who grew dragons by Andy Shepherd to inspire our writing. We will be retelling the story in our own words and using this to help us plan and write our own adventure stories. We will also be writing instructions on how to grow your own dragon.



Throughout this half term, we will be learning how to multiply 3 digit numbers by one, two and three digit numbers. We will be using our knowledge of the column method and applying it to multiplication. We will also be learning how to divide. We will learn a new method called the 'bus stop' method. We will be applying both these methods to a variety of problems.

In our science lessons this half term, we are going to be learning about animals, including consumers. We will be learning about whether animals have skeletons, whether they eat meat or not, and why they are adapted to their habitat. Our topic will include aquatic animals and what makes them different from land animals. We will be learning why certain predators are at the top of our food chain and what makes them the ultimate predator!

Spanish

During our Spanish lessons we will be focusing on animals. We will be pronouncing animal names, tell someone what our favourite animal is, recognising some animal nouns in the plural and writing Spanish sentence about what animals we can see.

In art, we will be doing sketching.
We will be focussing on Henri Rosseau and his artistic creations of jungle environments. By using cross-hatching and tone, we will be designing our own ultimate predator using our knowledge from our science lessons. We'll be focussing on not only the predator, but the environment they are in.

Music

As part of our music lessons, we will be focusing on melodies from Chinese New Year celebrations. We will be learning key musical terminology, playing, and creating pentatonic melodies, composing a piece of music using layered melodies.
