Spring Term One, Year 4

We hope you all had a lovely Christmas break and are ready for another fun filled term of learning. As part of our next topic, 'Where does our food go?' we will be working hard to understand our bodies even more by learning about the digestive system and teeth.

English

This half term we are going to be using the book 'The Miraculous Adventures of Edward Tulane' by Kate DiCamillo to inspire our writing. We will be using adventurous language to describe some of the characters, retelling part of the story and independently writing an additional chapter.



Throughout this half term, we will be focusing on learning a variety of methods to help us multiply and divide by 10 and 100. We will then be multiplying and dividing 2-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers and 3-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers, and using our knowledge of multiplication and division to help us solve a variety of problems.

In our science lessons this half term, we are going to be learning about the digestive system and the function of different organs in our bodies. We will also be learning about the four different types of teeth and what they are used for. We will discover whether all animals have the same teeth and we will investigate some more complex food chains.

Spanish

DT

During our Spanish lessons this half term, we will be learning how to say nouns and personal information about our family members. We will also be learning how to say some parts of our faces and will be using our knowledge to help us write simple sentences in Spanish. In DT, we will be looking at different types of stitches, including a running stitch, a cross stitch and a bench stitch. We will then use the knowledge of the stiches to help us design our own digestive system t-shirt. Afterwards, we are then going to create our own digestive system t-shirts using different materials and types of stitches.

Music

As part of our music lessons, we will be learning the changes in pitch, tempo and dynamics. We will be doing this with the theme of rivers. The stages of a river will link to our vocals and percussion instruments to produce a group performance to share with the class.
