Literacy

In our Literacy this half term we will be reading the following stories.

Topic

In topic we will be making links to Spring and noticing changes in the world around us.





We will be focusing on story telling, predicting what might happen next and trying to understand and describe how a character might be feeling. We will also be trying to hear rhyming words in these stories and suggest other words that could rhyme or sound the same. To help us hear the sounds in words we will be using musical instruments and taking part in lots of games that encourage us to clap along to a beat and clap the syllables in word.

We will also continue to practice writing our names and focus more on correct letter formation when doing so.

Maths

In math's we be focusing a lot on patterns and will be trying to make our own repeated patterns. We will also explore and use positional language, as well as continuing our number recognition and counting to 5.

We will discuss and learn about what plants need to grow and we will plant our own beanstalk.
