## Literacy

In our Literacy this half term we will be reading books about sea creatures that live under the sea.

## Maths

In maths we will be continuing with number recognition and counting to 5. We will be encouraging the children to use their fingers to represent numbers 0-5. We will also be linking numerals and amounts eg show the right number of objects to match the numeral up to 5.

This half term we will concentrate on our


understanding of the world around us.
