English

This half term we are going to be using the book 'How To Train Your Dragon' by Cressida Cowell to inspire our writing. We will writing character descriptions, retelling part of the story in our own words and writing non-chronological reports based on events and characters within the story.



Throughout this half term, we will be learning about decimals. We will begin by looking at tenths as fractions and exploring how these relate to tenths as decimals. Following this, we will learn to divide 1 and 2-digit numbers by 10 and 100, how to round to the nearest whole number and we will study halves and quarters as decimals.

History

In our history lessons this half term, we are going to be learning about the Vikings and Anglo-Saxons. We will be studying timelines to discover when in British history these periods of time were and will be learning key events that took place during each period. During the course of the half term, we will be studying a range of different artefacts to help us uncover what life was like too.
