Thank you for returning all the forms required for the trip next week. Here are some of the questions and their responses. For those who have requested a phone call, these will be made over the next few days.

<b>FAQ</b>	<b>Response</b>
What will my child wear on the day wear on the first day?	Please send your child to school wearing PE kit/Leaver's hoody for departure day
Will my child need towels?	Please ensure your child has a towel for the bathroom as well as a small one for the beach
How will my child receive their medication?	Mrs Ford will now have a medicine register based on the medical forms returned. This register will show who needs which medicine at set times. Another member of staff will be present for all administering.
Will my child be able to take a small night light/fan?	Children can bring a small night light or hand held fan for the night times.
How will my child's travel sickness be managed?	All travel sickness tablets will be given 30 minutes before departure. If a child is unwell on the coach, we will stop at the nearest rest break area. If they are unwell on the ferry, they will be given a quite space to sit away from large groups. Please ensure enough medication is provided for the week.
How long is the ferry ride?	The ferry will take approx. 1 hour.
How will my child's hay fever been managed?	We will ensure all medication is given regularly and cold compress' provided to help soothe their eyes – should this be required.
Will my child have a hat?	We have purchased baseball caps for each child to wear on each day trip to ensure their visibility whilst out and about.
